Meeting of the Administrative Board – November 27th, 2025

On November 27th, 2025, the Administrative Board of Danubius International University convened for an extraordinary meeting.

During the session, a series of decisions were unanimously approved by the attending members, concerning the university's academic and administrative activities.

We hereby publish the list of topics discussed and approved, while respecting institutional confidentiality:

- Endorsement of employment requests submitted by 7 teaching staff for the 2025–2026 academic year, as adjuncts;
- Endorsement of the application for teaching concurrently at other higher education institutions, for 1 teaching staff member;
- Approval of the establishment of two Master's degree programs, taught in English, within the School of International Governance and Law;
- Approval of the establishment of a study program taught in Romanian for foreign citizens, within the School of Smart Education and Innovative Educators;
- Re-approval of the establishment of a Bachelor's degree program in Pedagogy, within the School of Smart Education and Innovative Educators.
- Approval of the establishment of a Master's program taught in English and of a Master's program taught in Romanian, within the School of Global Business and Leadership.
- Approval of the establishment, within the School of Media, Design and Technology, of three study programs: one Master's program taught in Romanian, one Bachelor's program taught in Romanian, and one Bachelor's program with double specialization taught in English.

These decisions reflect the university's commitment to responsible, transparent governance, tailored to the needs of the academic community. In this regard, each adopted resolution contributes to the consolidation of a coherent institutional framework, where administrative and academic processes unfold in a harmonized and predictable manner. We aim for this approach to foster a climate of trust and collaboration, in which every member of the university community feels represented and actively contributes to the institution's development.
